



**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
ON
PERMIT APPLICATION FOR A
SOLID WASTE
COLLECTION/STORAGE/TRANSFER FACILITY**

**RUGGIERO PROCESSING FACILITY, LLC
32 INDUSTRIAL PARK ROAD, WALPOLE, NH**

The New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services, Waste Management Division (Department), has received a Type IA Permit Modification Application, pursuant to RSA 149-M:9, from Ruggiero Processing Facility, LLC, 32 Industrial Road, Walpole, NH, to collect, store, and transfer municipal solid waste. The facility is currently operating under a Standard Permit issued by the Department and is authorized to accept recyclable materials and construction demolition debris at an average weekly tonnage of 200 tons per week. This permit modification would increase the average weekly tonnage received at the facility to 400 tons per week and allow the facility to also accept municipal solid waste.

Pursuant to RSA 149-M:9 and Solid Waste Administrative Rule Env-Sw 304.08, a public hearing to receive testimony on this permit application will be held at the Walpole Town Hall, 34 Elm Street, Walpole, N.H. on Thursday, June 25, at 6 PM.

The permit application is available for public review during regular business hours at the Walpole Town Hall and in the Department's office at 29 Hazen Drive, Concord, NH and on the Department's website at <http://des.nh.gov/organization/divisions/waste/swmb/rpf-typeibapp.htm>.

Testimony may be submitted in writing to the Department at any time before close of the public hearing period, which is July 2, 2015 at 4:00 pm, in lieu of attending and/or providing oral testimony at the public hearing. Comments sent to other addresses will not be included in the public record.
