NOTICE OF TITLE V OPERATING PERMIT REVIEW
PUBLIC HEARING AND COMMENT PERIOD

Pursuant to the New Hampshire Code of Administrative Rules, Env-A 622.02, notice is hereby given that the Director of the New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services, Air Resources Division (Director), has received a Title V Operating Permit application from, and based on the information received to date, intends to **issue such Title V Operating Permit(s) to:**

Concord Steam Corp. is a wood & fossil fuel fired steam and electricity generating facility. The existing plant has a combined gross heat input of less than 250 MMBtu/hr consisting of four steam boilers. Concord Steam Corp. supplies thermal energy to a district heating system comprised of a number of publicly and privately owned buildings in Concord, NH. Steam is also used to generate electricity by means of two back pressure turbines rated at 1,500 kW and 750 kW respectively.

The completed application and draft permit is on file with the Director, New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services, Air Resources Division, 29 Hazen Drive, P.O.
