State Launches Climate Change Web Portal

*Website designed as a single-point of access to information related to
Climate Change in New Hampshire*

Concord, NH – The New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services Commissioner, Tom Burack announced today that the state has launched a web portal dedicated to the issue of climate change. The webpage, www.nh.gov/climate/, provides a list of on-line resources for information and activities specifically related to climate change/global warming in New Hampshire.

Tom Burack, DES Commissioner, noted, “Climate change is one of the most critical issues that we in New Hampshire face today. With so many people, organizations and groups, working on this issue, it makes sense to provide a web-based clearinghouse of all the on-line information that is available. This website serves as an important resource so that we may all become better educated about climate change and about the many positive changes that each of us can make to protect our environment and quality of life here in New Hampshire.”

The website specifically provides on-line information. Additional groups or organizations may be actively concerned with climate change, but may not have a dedicated web page on the subject.
