



**WASTE MANAGEMENT SPECIALIST III  
Position #14801**

The New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services, Waste Management Division has an immediate opening for a Waste Management Specialist III position. This position inspects hazardous waste generators and investigates hazardous waste complaints to enforce state hazardous waste laws and regulations under the jurisdiction of the Waste Management Division, Waste Management Programs; communicates technical information and provides assistance to federal, state, and local agencies, the regulated community and the public in order to ensure that they are adequately and accurately informed of the program's activities.

This position requires excellent verbal and written communication skills, would have attention to detail, ability to document observations in written reports. Must be able to pass baseline medical examination indicating the individual is physically capable of assuming all duties required including wearing respiratory protective equipment in accordance with the recommendations of the National Institute of Occupational Health and Safety.

Minimum requirements for this position are a bachelor's degree with major study in chemistry, environmental health, biological sciences, hydrology, or other related environmental science and Five years' experience required in hazardous waste management, environmental monitoring or testing, hazardous materials handling, occupational safety and health or related field OR five years' experience in solid waste management, hydrogeology, waste treatment systems or other related scientific fields. Each additional year of approved formal education may be substituted for one year of required work experience.

The salary range for this position is \$46,390.50 - \$55,126.50. Three additional steps may be awarded based on successful performance evaluations. The selected candidate must satisfactorily pass criminal background and driver record checks and will have to pay a union/agency fee at a future date.
