The New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services, Water Division, Watershed Management Bureau has an immediate opening for a part-time Environmental Technician III position. This position will conduct field surveys to monitor technical aspects of the New Hampshire Marine Toilets and Disposal of Sewage from Boats Program including conducting inspections, compiling data for reports, providing education and outreach to the boating community, and enforcing the No Discharge Law. The perfect candidate would have thorough knowledge of marine mechanics; knowledge of state and federal marine pollution laws; good skills in written and verbal communication; and the ability to work independently and communicate with state agencies, marinas, individuals, and other related parties. This position will be scheduled for a maximum of 15 hours per week.

Minimum qualifications for this position is Associate's degree or two years of college with a major study in environmental engineering, one of the physical or biological sciences, or other related environmental science. Two years' experience performing technical environmental work in air analysis, noise or water quality control, forestry, soils, hydrology, geology, botany, biology or a related environmental field. Education and experience may be interchanged as appropriate. Must possess a valid New Hampshire driver's license and a valid New Hampshire Boating Education Certificate.

The salary range for this position is \$15.91 - 18.54 per hour. *The successful hired candidate must satisfactorily pass a criminal background and driver's record checks.* Health insurance benefits are not available with this position.
