

Dear Mr. Nusimovich:

The Department of Environmental Services, Waste Management Division (DES) has received your letter dated November 14, 2012 requesting acceptance of a Hazardous Waste Notification Form Update applicable to the Hazardous Waste Transfer Facility Permit held by United Oil Recovery, Inc., located in Newington, New Hampshire. United Oil Recovery, Inc., a Connecticut Corporation, will change its name to Tradebe Treatment and Recycling Northeast, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company, effective December 31, 2012.

The Hazardous Waste Transfer Facility Permit has been modified to reflect the change in name and will identify the permittee as Tradebe Treatment and Recycling Northeast, LLC. Please attach a copy of the enclosed Record of Permit Modification to your Permit No. DES-HW-TF-2000-01 and Permit No. DES-HW-IP-TF-2000-01 to provide a clear permanent record of the permit modification. This action only changes the name by which the facility is referred. No other aspects of the permit are changed by this action.

Please be advised, per Env-Hw 304.25, which incorporates by reference 40 CFR 270.42 (a)(ii), Tradebe Treatment and Recycling Northeast, LLC must send notice of the modification to all persons on the facility mailing list. The notice must be sent within 90 calendar days after the change is put into effect.



- III. **MODIFICATION:** The name of the facility is changed from "United Oil Recovery, Inc." to "Tradebe Treatment and Recycling Northeast, LLC". Consequently, all occurrences in Permit No. DES-HW-TF-2000-01 and Permit No. DES-HW-IP-TF-2000-01 of the words "United Oil Recovery, Inc." are hereby changed to "Tradebe Treatment and Recycling Northeast, LLC". This modification does not authorize a change in ownership or operational control of the facility. No other changes or modifications to Permit No. DES-HW-TF-2000-01 and Permit No. DES-HW-IP-TF-2000-01 are authorized by this Permit Modification.

- IV. **EFFECTIVE DATE:** The Permit Modification is effective December 31, 2012.

- V. **AUTHORIZATIONSIGNATURE:** The permit identified in Section I above is hereby modified as specified in Section III above. This authorization is based on information and representations provided to the Department by the permittee in documents referenced in Section II above. If the information is false, misleading or incomplete, the modification may be revoked or suspended in accordance with Department procedures.

BY EXERCISING ANY RIGHTS UNDER THIS AUTHORIZATION, THE PERMITTEE HAS AGREED TO ALL TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THIS PERMIT, AS MODIFIED. Failure to comply with these terms and conditions could result in administrative, civil or criminal penalties, and suspension or revocation of the permit. No liability is incurred by the State of New Hampshire by reason of any approval of this hazardous waste transfer facility. No warranty/guarantee is intended or implied by reason of any advice given by the Department or its staff.

This permit modification shall not eliminate the permittee's obligation to obtain all requisite federal, state or local permits, licenses or approvals, or to comply with all other applicable federal, state, district and local permits, ordinances, laws, approvals or conditions relating to the operation of the Hazardous Waste Transfer facility.
