These training sessions are designed to assist you as you fill out the self-certification form.

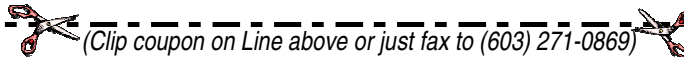

## DIRECTIONS

### **Exeter Public Library - 1 Founders Park, Exeter, NH; (603) 772-6036**

For directions from the library web site: [www.exeterpl.org/direct.html](http://www.exeterpl.org/direct.html)

**DO NOT PARK IN THE LIBRARY PARKING LOT!** Use the nearby municipal lot or park on the street. **From the West:** Take RTE 101 E to Exit 10 (RTE 85), Newfields Rd. At the end of ramp, turn right onto RTE 85 S. Follow to the end of RTE 85. Turn left onto Water St. (RTE 27). Follow to stop sign at Bandstand in the center of Exeter. Take first left onto String Bridge St. Cross String Bridge St. The Library is a brick building on the right. **From the North, South or East:** Take I-95 to Exit 2 (RTE 101 Exeter/Hampton) Take 101 W to Exit 11 (RTE 108), Portsmouth Ave. Bear left at the end of ramp, onto RTE 108. Follow to RTE 111/108 (High St). Turn right onto RTE 111/108. Take 2nd right onto Pleasant St. Take 1st left onto String Bridge St. The Library is a brick building on the left. **DO NOT PARK IN THE LIBRARY PARKING LOT!** Use the nearby municipal lot or park on the street.

### **Derry Public Library, 64 East Broadway (Route 102), Derry, NH; (603) 432-6140**

**DO NOT PARK IN THE LIBRARY PARKING LOT!** Please use the municipal parking lot adjacent to the Masonic building. **From the North or South:** Take I-93 to Exit 4 onto RTE 102 (Nashua Rd.) east toward Derry. Go about 1.1 miles. The Library is located on the left off RTE 102. **DO NOT PARK IN THE LIBRARY PARKING LOT!** Please use the municipal parking lot adjacent to the Masonic building.

### **NH Department of Environmental Services - Concord, 29 Hazen Drive, Concord, NH; (603) 271-3503**

**From the South and West:** Take I-93 N to Exit 14. Turn left onto Loudon Rd. At third light turn left onto Hazen Dr. Turn left at sign for Health & Human Services. **From the North:** Take I-93 S to Exit 15 E onto I-393 E. Take Exit 2 and turn left onto East Side Dr. Turn right at light onto Hazen Dr. Turn right at sign for Health & Human Services. **From the East:** Take RTE 4 W to Concord (RTE 4 becomes I-393 in Concord). Take Exit 2 and turn left onto East Side Dr. Turn right at second light onto Hazen Dr. Turn right at sign for Health & Human Services.

### **Rochester Public Library, 65 South Main Street, Rochester, NH; (603) 332-1428**

**From the South:** Take Exit 12 off the RTE 16 (Spaulding Turnpike) and bear right onto RTE 125. Follow RTE 125 through four sets of lights (road curves left), then get into the left lane. Continue to next set of lights. You'll see Walgreen's across the intersection, on the right. Turn left onto Main St. Continue in left lane. On your left you'll see a Friendly's just before the library. Turn left into the entrance after Friendly's. Park in the rear lot. **From the North:** Take Exit 13 off the Spaulding Turnpike and turn left onto Washington St. Continue on Washington St until it runs into Main St. Bear right onto Main St. Go straight through downtown past two sets of lights. Stay in the right lane. Go past a white church on the right. The library is the next building on the right. Turn right just after the library, and before Friendly's. Park in the rear lot. **From Route 202:** RTE 202 turns into Washington St. as you pass under the Spaulding Turnpike. Continue on Washington St. until it runs into Main St. Bear right onto Main St. Go straight through downtown past two sets of lights. Stay in right lane. Go past a white church on the right. The library is the next building on the right. Turn right just after the library, and before Friendly's. Park in the rear lot.

**From the West:** Take RTE 4 E to RTE 16 S (Spaulding Tpk). Take Exit 1, Gosling Rd./ Pease Int'l Tradeport. Turn right off exit onto Pease Blvd. Turn left at first traffic light onto International Dr. Turn right at 4-way intersection onto Manchester Square. Turn first left into parking lot. NHDES is first building on left, entrance in rear. **From the North:** Take I-95 S to Exit 5 (RTE 4/NH RTE 16). Merge onto RTE 16 N (Spaulding Tpk). Take Exit 1, Gosling Rd./ Pease Int'l Tradeport and follow the above directions (from the West) for from this point forward. **From the South:** Take I-95 N to Exit 4 (RTE 4/NH RTE 16 – NH Lakes/White Mtns). Merge onto RTE 16 N (Spaulding Tpk). Take Exit 1, Gosling Rd./ Pease Int'l Tradeport and follow the above directions (from the West) for from this point forward.
