<p><u>NH DES - CONCORD</u> (603) 271-2942 29 Hazen Drive Concord, NH www.des.nh.gov</p>	<p>From the South and West: Take I-93 north to Exit 14 and turn right at the end of the ramp. At third light (at top of hill) turn left onto Hazen Drive. Turn left at sign for Health & Human Services. From the North: Take I-93 south to Exit 15E onto I-393. Take Exit 2 and turn left at end of exit ramp (onto East Side Drive). Stay to the right and turn right at light onto Hazen Drive. Turn right at sign for Health & Human Services. From the East: Take Rte 4 west to Concord (Rte 4 becomes I-393 in Concord). Take Exit 2 and turn left at end of exit ramp. Stay to the right and turn right at second light onto Hazen Drive. Turn right at sign for Health & Human Services.</p>
<p><u>CONWAY FIRE STATION</u> (603) 447-2681 97 Main Street Conway, NH <i>Parking: Please park to the south of the Fire Department, behind the park – there is plenty of space.</i></p>	<p>Traveling NORTH from the Spaulding Turnpike: Take the Spaulding Turnpike to Rte 16 North into the center of Conway Village. The Conway Fire Department is on the right. Traveling EAST from Twin Mountain: Take Rte 302 East. At the Junction of Rtes 16 and 302 in Glen, head south on Rte 16 toward North Conway. Stay on Rte 16 South at the intersection. The Conway Fire Department is on the left. Traveling EAST from I-93: From I-93 heading south, take Exit 32 to Rte 112 East. Continue on the Kancamangus Highway to Conway. Go left onto Rte 16/Main Street. The Conway Fire Department is on the right. OR From I-93 heading north, take Exit 23 and go right onto Rte 104 for about 8 miles. Turn left onto Rte 3. Turn right onto Rte 25 at the intersection of Rtes 3 and 25. Follow Rte 25, then go left onto Rte 16 North into the center of Conway Village. The Conway Fire Department is on the right. Traveling SOUTH from Berlin: Take Rte 16 South to Gorham. Continuing south through town on Rtes 16S & Rte 2E, go right after the park onto Rte 16S. Approximately 22 miles later, at the Junction of Rtes 16 and 302, take a left to continue onto Rte 16 to North Conway. Continue heading south passing downtown shops and restaurants for about five miles. Take a right onto Main Street at the intersection. The Conway Fire Department is on the left. Traveling WEST from MAINE on Rte 302: From Rte 302, traveling WEST, go through Fryeburg, ME where Rte 302 and 113 join. Take Rte 302/113 through Center Conway. At intersection of Rtes 302 and 113 continue going straight on Rte 113 approx. 1.5 miles to intersection of Rtes 113 & 16. Follow Rte 16 South onto Main Street. The Conway Fire Department is on the left.</p>
<p><u>NH DES - GORHAM</u> (603) 466-5389 80 Glen Road Gorham, NH</p>	<p>From the South: Take Rte 16 north. DES is on the left soon after the speed limit changes to 30 mph in Gorham. There is a sign for DES and Revenue Administration on the front lawn. The class room is in the rear building. Please park in the rear parking lot. From the West or North: Take Rte 2 east or Rte 16 south. Continue to go east on Rte 2 and south on Rte 16 from the traffic light at the junction of Rtes 2 and 16. Go through town to the Town Common and ball field (on the right) and then take a right on Rte 16 south. The DES office is located on the right approximately ¼ of a mile south of the Gorham Town Common or the junction of Rtes 16 and 2 and across the street from the Libby Recreational Area. There is a sign for DES and Revenue Administration on the front lawn. The class room is in the rear building. Please park in the rear parking lot.</p>
<p><u>CLAREMONT SAVINGS BANK</u> (603) 542-7711 145 Broad Street Claremont, NH <i>Parking: Please do not park in the spots immediate to the bank. Park in any other free spots.</i></p>	<p>From Interstate 91 (Vermont): Take exit 8 (Ascutney). From the North, turn left onto Rte 12 toward NH. From the South, turn right onto Rte 12 toward NH. At roundabout in Claremont, take 2nd exit onto Rte 11/Broad St. Keep straight onto Broad St. the Claremont Savings Bank will be on the right. From Interstate 89 (New Hampshire): Take exit 12 (Sunapee, Claremont, Newport). From the North, turn right onto Rte 11. From the South, turn left onto Rte 11. Follow Rte 11 through Sunapee to Newport. In Newport, take Rte 11 and 103 to Claremont (approximately 10 miles). Turn right on Tremont St. to stay on Rte 11 and Rte 103. At the roundabout, take 3rd exit and keep straight onto Broad St. The Claremont Savings Bank will be on the right.</p>
<p><u>FREUDENBERG - NOK</u> (603) 744-2281 450 Pleasant Street Bristol, NH</p>	<p>From I-93 North or South: Take exit 23. From the North, turn right at the end of the ramp. From the South, turn left at the end of the ramp. Follow Route 104 into Bristol. At the light, turn left following Route 104. After about 1/4 mile, pass Homeland Cemetery (on the right) and turn right into Freudenberg-NOK. Immediately after turning in, take the next left toward "Visitor Parking" and park in those spaces in front of the building. The entrance to the training room is different from the front lobby. Please follow the sign at the walkway entrance to the Training Room (it will be to your far left).</p>
