MODIFICATION: The final plans and specifications provided in the documents identified above in Section II and submitted by the permittee pursuant to Env-Sw 305.05(b) and Section 8 of the facility permit, are approved for construction, subject to the terms and conditions provided in Section IV below and waiver #DES-SW-WV-15-004 approved on this date and attached hereto. The approved plans and specifications are for construction of Stage 2 of closure, which constitutes the remaining 7.7 acres of landfill, including capping the remaining areas of Phases III and IV, and all of Phase V.

IV. TERMS AND CONDITIONS: The permittee shall comply with the construction requirements in Env-Sw 1104, including but not limited to filing a Notice of Intent to Construct per Env-Sw 1104.02 and satisfying the reporting requirements in Env-Sw 1104.07.

VI. AUTHORIZING SIGNATURE: The permit identified in Section I above is hereby modified as specified in Section III above. This authorization is based on information and representations provided to the Department by the permittee, in documents referenced in Section II above. If the information is false, misleading or incomplete, the modification may be revoked or suspended in accordance with Part Env-Sw 306 of the New Hampshire Solid Waste Rules.

BY EXERCISING ANY RIGHTS UNDER THIS AUTHORIZATION, THE PERMITTEE HAS AGREED TO ALL TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE PERMIT, AS MODIFIED. Failure to comply with the terms and conditions of the permit could result in administrative, civil or criminal enforcement action and penalties, and suspension or revocation of the permit. No liability is incurred by the State of New Hampshire by reason of any approval of this solid waste facility. No warranty/guarantee is intended or implied by reason of any advice given by the Department or its staff.

This permit shall not eliminate the permittee's obligation to obtain all requisite federal, state or local permits, licenses or approvals, or to comply with all other applicable federal, state, district and local permits, ordinances, laws, approvals or conditions relating to the facility.
