Dear Mr. Ruggiero:

The New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services, Waste Management Division (Department) has completed a review of the above-cited Type IA permit modification application. In accordance with the requirements of the New Hampshire Solid Waste Rules (Rules), the following information must be provided to satisfy the provisions of Env-Sw 304.03 for a completeness determination, and Env-Sw 304.07 and Env-Sw 315 for a technical review.

Completeness

1. Env-Sw 315.05(i and j), as part of Section IX of the Application, were not addressed. These need to be addressed when the application is first submitted to the Department. Please explain. Please also copy the municipality, districts, and other affected entities on every submittal to the Department pertaining to this Application.

2. In Section VI(2), please address all the requirements of Env-Sw 1005.01(d), not just odors and vectors.

3. Section 1.03 does not state the amount of construction and demolition debris that will be stored on site. Please explain.
4. In Section 6.01(6), 4th paragraph, 1st bullet point, it is mentioned that batteries will be stored in overseas containers. Please explain if these batteries will be shipped in these 8'x40' containers, and what other items will be shipped in these containers.

5. Section 7.01 mentions the term "level IV operator." However, the new rules adopted on July 1, 2014 do not include levels. Please update section 7.01 and other portions of Section 7.0 to incorporate Env-Sw 1600, Solid Waste Facility Operator Training and Certification rules. A link to these rules is <http://des.nh.gov/organization/commissioner/legal/rulemaking/documents/env-sw1600-adpt-pstd.pdf>.
6. Env-Ws is referenced in Section 8.03. Please revise this to Env-Sw if this is a solid waste reference.
7. Section 8.02 still references Env-Sw 315(g). However, this rule reference does not exist. Please explain.
8. In Appendix E, Access Agreement, it states "this agreement is for the convenience of Ruggiero and thus, can be terminated by Hodgkins at will, with no justification necessary, provided 90 days advance written notice is given to Ruggiero." Please provide a guarantee the site will have access to Industrial Park Drive.

9. The response to the Site Plan #34 question states non-recyclable construction and demolition debris goes into the bulk dumpster. However, no bulk dumpster can be found on the plans. Please explain.

Please address the above comments by submitting one copy of the required information. Be certain to note the revision date on each replacement page. Continued review of your application will commence upon receipt of this information.

Until the Department has completed its completeness and technical reviews, there may be additional comments. In the meantime, if you have any questions, please contact me.
