Dear Mr. Ruggiero:

The New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services, Waste Management Division (Department) has completed a review of the above-cited Type IB permit modification application. In accordance with the requirements of the New Hampshire Solid Waste Rules (Rules), the following information must be provided to satisfy the provisions of Env-Sw 304.03 for a completeness determination, and Env-Sw 304.07 and Env-Sw 315 for a technical review.

Completeness

1. Per Section III(5) of the Application, a Site Plan is required. Please show on the Site Plan where municipal solid waste (MSW) bulk containers will be brought in, stored, and transferred, where the locations of the construction and demolition debris and recyclables are stored, and where the loading tunnel referenced in Section 3.02(2)(a) of the Operating Plan is located.
2. Per Env-Sw 304.03(f), please submit all disclosure forms required pursuant to Env-Sw 316 to the NHDOJ.
3. Per Env-Sw 304.06(a)(3) and Env-Sw 304.08(b), a public hearing is required.

4. In Appendix D, a Level IV Operator is mentioned. The Solid Waste Operator rules have been revised and the Level IV designation is no longer used. Please update this reference to incorporate the designation in <http://des.nh.gov/organization/commissioner/legal/rulemaking/documents/env-sw1600-adpt-pstd.pdf>.
5. Section 1.04 in the Operating Plan mentioned that MSW will be transferred from a small bulk container to a larger bulk container. Please explain if the MSW will be stored on site before it is loaded on to the larger bulk containers. Please explain in this section if recyclables will be removed from the MSW while on site.

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6. In Section 3.02(2)(c), it mentions MSW loads are tipped on the tipping floor. Please explain how the MSW is prevented from mixing with recyclables or construction and demolition debris. Please also explain where in the building the loading tunnel is located.
7. Section 4.02(2) references Env-Wm 402. Please update this reference to the current rule nomenclature.
8. Section I(5) of the Application lists a more complete address than is shown in Section 1.01 of the Operating Plan and Section 1.0 in the Closure Plan. Please explain.


Closure Cost Estimate

9. The Financial Assurance rules located in Env-Sw 1400 were revised as of July 1, 2014. Please ensure the Closure Cost Estimate reflects these new rules. 10. Appendix B of the Operating Plan lists waste facilities for construction and demolition debris and recyclables. Please explain if these facilities will also be used for MSW. Please include a disposal destination for MSW in the Closure Cost Estimate.
11. The line item for non-recyclables sums to \$1,350; however, the total cost column shows \$4,450. Please explain. Since MSW is also a non-recyclable, please re-describe the phrase "Non-Recyclables" in the "Permitted Material" column.

Please address the above comments by submitting one copy of the required information. Be certain to note the revision date on each replacement page. Continued review of your application will commence upon receipt of this information.
