Dear Mr. Stevens:

The New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services, Waste Management Division (Department) has completed a review of the subject application. In accordance with the requirements of the New Hampshire Solid Waste Rules (Rules) [ref. Env-Sw 304.03], the Department has determined that the application is incomplete and has the following comments:

1. A person conducting business under any name other than his/her own legal name must register with the Secretary of State's office. For example, John D. Smith doing business as "John D. Smith" **does not** have to register; however, if he conducts business as "John Smith Enterprises" he **does** have to register as "Enterprises" is not part of his legal name. Please register Stevens Salvage with the Secretary of State's office.
2. Section XII (7) states "for a facility having a life longer than 90 days, at least 50% of the on-site personnel who are directly involved with the management of solid waste shall be operators who have been issued certification in accordance with Env-Sw 1600 and, for every 1 to 5 operators, there shall be at least one supervisor who is certified as a level III or Level IV operator in accordance with Env-Sw 1600." 3. As discussed on the phone, please provide information regarding the right-of-way between Stevens Salvage and adjacent lot.
