



# Land Resource Management Workshop

The workshop is geared towards those involved with land development, and land conservation and management, from consultants and environmental professionals to municipal employees, non-profit organizations and volunteers.

**This workshop, offered on three dates, will provide the following information about current and upcoming requirements and activities for several DES programs.**

## **Comprehensive Shoreland Protection Act Overview**

An overview of the most recent CSPA amendments, which became effective in September 2009, and a thorough review of the shoreland permitting process, including how to avoid common pitfalls.

## **What is the Board of Natural Scientists and what does it do?**

Information about the function of the Board of Natural Scientists (one of the boards under the Joint Board of Licensure), who is on the board, the certification process and terms for wetland or soil scientists, and how the board handles complaints regarding professional practice and ethics.

## **How the River Runs Through It**

An introduction to the basics of river processes, or fluvial geomorphology. This will set the context for a discussion of the effects of the installation of structures within a river channel, and the importance of structures that are sized to allow the normal passage of river water, sediment and aquatic organisms, thus minimizing adverse impacts.

## **Wetland Permitting Updates**

Update on wetlands permitting, including a review of the changes made in the 2009 legislative session and subsequent activities.

## **Stream Crossing Rules (Final proposal)**

A review of the stream crossing rules that are in the rulemaking process. Information about how they apply to various projects and situations will be discussed.

## **Need More than One Permit?**

Session will help in choosing which permit to pursue first if more than one is needed, e.g., wetlands, shoreland, alteration of terrain and/or septic/subdivision.

## **Subsurface Systems Bureau Update**

An overview of revisions to the statute (RSA 485-A) and rules (Env-Wq 1000), as well as key aspects of the design review and inspection process.
