In compliance with Laws of 2002, Chapter 278, the Souhegan River Technical Review Committee is pleased to submit this annual report of the committee's findings and activities for 2010. This law defines the two committees for each river under the pilot program to advise the Instream Flow process—the Technical Review Committee (TRC) and the Water Management Area Advisory Committee (WMPAAC). According to Chapter 278, “The instream flow Technical Review Committees shall make annual reports regarding their progress and findings on or before November 1 of each year of their existence to the Senate President, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, the Governor, the Commissioner of the Department of Environmental Services, and the State Library.”

The Committee has completed its primary duty described by Laws of 2002, Chapter 278, which was to direct DES in the conduct of the Protected Instream Flow Study. Documentation of the study results is in the report titled **Souhegan River Protected Instream Flow Report** and dated February 26, 2008. The committee will continue to exist to oversee implementation of the provisions of the pilot program under the Water Management Plan. The Water Management Plan is primarily the responsibility of the WMPAAC, but the technical details of implementation may be of interest to the TRC members.
