3. This certification will be posted to the Department of Environmental Services website as well as the official ARRA website, [www.recovery.gov](http://www.recovery.gov).

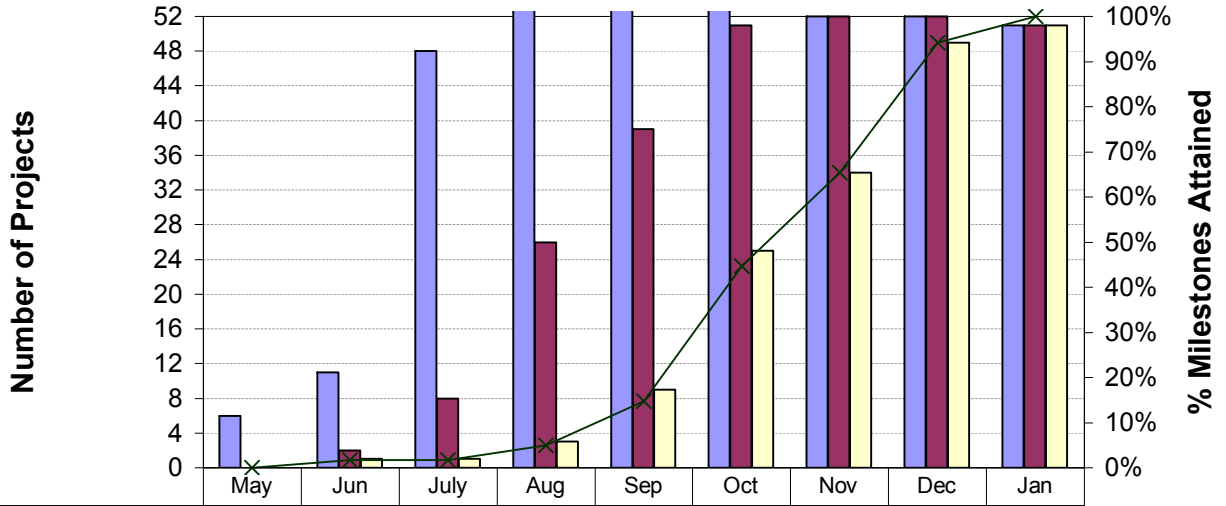

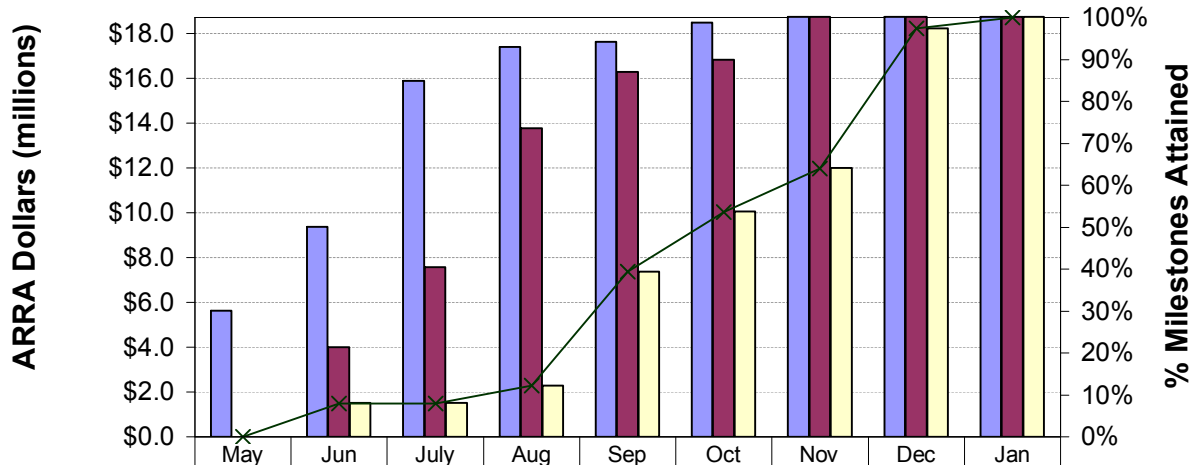
